



THE FEFCO EVENT APP

1. Download and install the app:

• On your mobile device, go to the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android), search Cvent Events and download the app.

• Enter FEFC0 Technical Seminar 2025 or event ID FEFTS25 in the search bar.


