Paper, board and glass are circular materials, sustainability is in their DNA with record-breaking recycling rates, the infinite recycling of glass, while paper and cardboard are made of renewable raw materials. These are truly sustainable materials. That is why we are following the PPWR negotiations so closely.

State of play: Long is the road that the PPWR has already travelled. After the EU Commission launched its proposal for a new packaging legislation at the end of November 2022, the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union have since published their proposed amendments.

Many of the amendments proposed should bring pragmatism and science into the PPWR, improving its link with existing national legislation. The Belgian paper, cardboard and glass industries call on the negotiating parties to keep that pragmatism as a priority. It is pragmatism and a scientific approach that will provide the environmental benefits which are the objective of the PPWR. Neither the European manufacturing industry nor the EU population will benefit from legislation that is unenforceable, requires enormous effort and investment to implement h and which will not bring the expected environmental improvements. We therefore call upon the European Parliament to strongly defend their position and stay close to their approved amendments.
