## FEFCO Voluntary Agreement to Phase out DiBP

**Brussels 26 January 2009,** FEFCO, the European Federation of Corrugated Board Manufacturers, has reached a voluntary agreement to coordinate a common strategy for the whole industry to phase out DiBP in corrugated products.

Di-iso-butylphthalate (DiBP) is used as a softening agent in some adhesives. Some recent studies<sup>1</sup> have shown that DiBP has a similar toxicological profile as Dibutylphthalate (DBP) which has been included in the candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) recently<sup>2</sup> published by ECHA (European Chemicals Agency).

FEFCO represents 750 plants across Europe and is the only European Association representing the Corrugated Board Industry in Europe.

After considerable activity at European level, the corrugated sector, through its association, FEFCO, has recommended its members to remove adhesives containing phthalate in products.

The result of this recommendation is the voluntary initiative for the removal of Di-isobutylphthalate (DiBP) from their products respecting the following guidelines:

- 1. FEFCO Members will cease using adhesives containing DiBP in paper and board applications.
- 2. DiBP should not be replaced by any substance which is known to have harmful effects.
- 3. FEFCO Members will report on the measures taken on an annual basis.

FEFCO will promote its voluntary agreement at international level within the International Corrugated Case Association (ICCA) in order to convince overseas

producers of corrugated board to phase out the use of DiBP, which will help to reduce further the level of DiBP in the recycling loop.
