

## FEFCO COMMON FOOTPRINT

### FOCUS ON FRUIT & VEGETABLES TRAYS

#### 1. What does COMMON FOOTPRINT mean?

Common size and position for tabs and receptacles → universal stackability of trays with identical external dimensions for all conceptions and/or designs.

#### 2. Conditions for the eligibility of the CF Stamp

- Tabs and receptacles must have identical standard dimensions (detailed description below).
- Positions must be standard (detailed technical specifications below).
- Trays' external dimensions must strictly be applied to all the designs of produced trays/boxes.

a. Required dimensions (Base dimensions measured in millimeters: L x W)

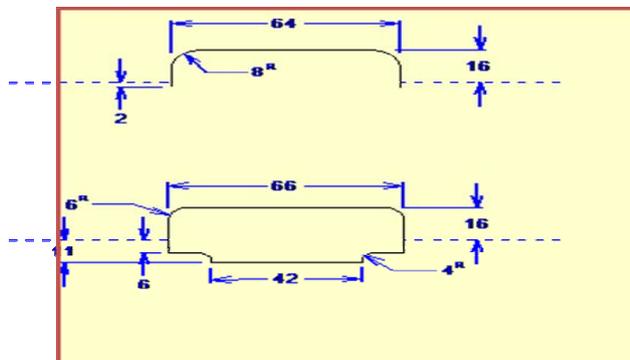
**Theoretical dimensions**  
(measures used for ordering & discussions)

298 x 198	→	300 x 200box

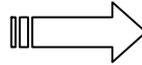
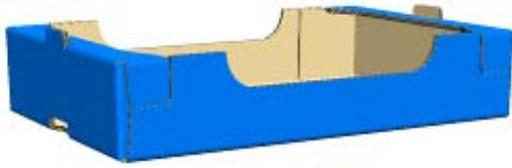
Normal industrial tolerance: +/- 1mm  
Height not specified, upon request from the client.

b. Universal Tabs / Receptacles

These technical specifications need be followed for the application of the “**FEFCO CF Stamp**” on any box.

**CF → Immediately**

100% stackable for immediate release if columns with same bottom (for high volume and new business development).

3. The terms of use of the application of the FEFCO CF Stamp



FEFCO CF Stamp is available for download on the FEFCO website.

- a. Rights of Usage  
All manufacturers that use packaging, fulfilling the technical requirements as described above are free to use the stamp on packaging made out of paper, solid board and corrugated board.
- b. Use of the CF Stamp  
The FEFCO CF Stamp shall be conspicuously placed on all packaging (on the bottom of the packaging/tray or where ever it is visible). Recommended minimum symbol diameter is 40mm. It will be leading on all others bottom printing.
- c. Mismanagement  
Any mismanagement of the FEFCO CF Stamp will become an action of an injunction.
